Day 1: Thursday, October 8, 2026 Overnight Flight

Discover a dramatic waterway where winding valleys give way to riverside cities and Alpine hamlets. Venture along the Rhine and Moselle and spend time in beloved European cities, getting a taste of the local culture in each stop along the way.

Day 2: Friday, October 9, 2026 Amsterdam, Netherlands - Board Cruise Ship

Arrive in Amsterdam, a city of narrow canals and stone bridges, where you will board your ship in the afternoon.* Your home for the next seven nights, this ship offers an array of amenities including outside staterooms, delicious food and wine at every dinner, and daily onboard musical performances. As arrival times will vary, there's no scheduled sightseeing today. A welcome room will be provided for early arrivals in one of the hotels, and you can spend the morning as you wish, exploring the city independently. This evening, meet in the lounge for a cocktail reception followed by a welcome aboard dinner. (D)

Day 3: Saturday, October 10, 2026 Amsterdam

Embark on a tour of Amsterdam with a local expert before seeing the city from a different perspective, voyaging along the city's centuries-old canal system. Sail by charming cafés and famous 16th-century row houses stacked side-by-side. Afterward, travel by coach to rejoin your ship downriver for lunchtime onboard. This afternoon, relax as your ship departs the Netherlands and makes its way to Germany. (*B*, *L*, *D*)

Day 4: Sunday, October 11, 2026 Cologne, Germany

As the sun rises, glide along the Rhine River and pass through the picturesque German landscapes dotted with medieval towns. Your journey brings you to Cologne, where you will join a guide for a walking tour of the city's Gothic Old Town. Wander along cobblestone streets and admire the Cologne Cathedral, the Roman Dionysus mosaic, and the Romanesque church of St. Martin. Top off this walking tour with a tasting of Cologne's famous Kölsch beer. (*B, L, D*)

Day 5: Monday, October 12, 2026 Cochem - Alken

Start your morning in Cochem, a storybook town overlooking the water. Embark on a guided tour through the town and into Reichsburg Castle,** a fortress perched high upon a hill with a stunning view of Cochem and the Moselle Valley below. Travelling by coach, you'll rejoin your ship in Alken to spend a scenic afternoon and evening sailing along the Rhine and through the Lorelei Passage, the river's narrowest point, named for a storied siren. (*B*, *L*, *D*)

Day 6: Tuesday, October 13, 2026 Mannheim - Speyer

The river takes you to Mannheim where you will have free time to explore this German city and its parks on your own. Perhaps you will join an optional excursion to Heidelberg, an ancient city of Renaissance buildings and castle ramparts. Later, sail to Speyer, one of Germany's oldest cities, where **it's your choice!** Get to know Speyer on a walking tour where you will trace the story of Speyer's Jewish community from the year 1084 to today, visiting significant UNESCO sites **-OR-** follow guides on a journey back in time to discover the everyday lives of citizens in the Middle Ages. End your day at the Captain's Gala Dinner – a lively celebration of food, music and entertainment. (*B*, *L*, *D*)

Day 7: Wednesday, October 14, 2026 Strasbourg, France

Cross the French border and experience Strasbourg, a fairytale town that blends centuries of international influences to create its own unique culture. On a guided walking tour through the old quarter, *Petite France*, and a canal cruise, take in the iconic timber-framed houses, the Cathedral of Notre Dame, and Place de la République. Make the most of your free time in the afternoon by exploring this perfectly preserved town. Aboard the ship, toast to the end of a fabulous journey at your farewell dinner. (*B*, *L*, *D*)

Day 8: Thursday, October 15, 2026 Breisach, Germany - Freiburg - Breisach

This morning, arrive back in Germany and experience Breisach, one of the oldest towns in the country. Spend the morning strolling through its picturesque alleys and colourful market square on a guided tour before continuing by coach to Freiburg, the capital of the Black Forest region. This afternoon, enjoy some free time back in Breisach to explore on your own. Perhaps you'll visit one of the town's many cafés or ice cream shops before your ship departs for Basel. (*B*, *L*, *D*)

Day 9: Friday, October 16, 2026 Basel, Switzerland -Disembark Ship - Tour Ends

Travel from Amsterdam, Netherlands to Basel, Switzerland in style. Along the way, you gain a new perspective that only a river and land travel experience can offer.

Important Tour Information:

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel. Walking two to three miles over the course of a day is no problem for you. You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. Expect some full days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travellers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

**In Cochem, the included walking tour is approximately 3 hours in duration. There is substantial walking required to cross the bridge into town and expect to navigate through cobblestone streets on your way to Reichsburg Castle. To access the castle, there's a ramp to walk up and there are no elevators available.

While this tour is appropriate for travellers that require some mobility assistance devices, river cruises cannot accommodate travellers on wheelchairs or with restricted mobility due to gangway access, mooring requirements, and lack of elevator accessibility to every deck of the ship.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

***The driving distance from Basel to Zurich is 54 miles/87 kilometers and expected travelling time is 1.5 hours depending on traffic.

In Mannheim and Strasbourg, depending on the docking position, the ship may not be docked within walking distance to the old city.

Ports of call are subject to change based on pier availability and weather conditions.

This itinerary is subject to change due to unforeseen changes in water levels, delays at the locks, and other circumstances that may arise along the waterways. These changes may include items being missed during the tour; however, every effort will be made to substitute another attraction if possible.

Smart casual wear is recommended throughout the tour. For the welcome and farewell dinners, a dinner dress for ladies and jacket and tie for gentlemen is recommended. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended throughout the tour.

*Depending on your arrival time in Amsterdam, you may have free time to explore Amsterdam on your own prior to embarkation.

Coffee or tea is included with all meals. Wine, beer, and soda are included with each dinner onboard the ship.

Gratuities for cabin stewards, bus boys, and waiters onboard the ship are not included.

Cabins are available on Main (Ariane), Middle (Alexia), and Upper (Amalia) decks. Please note, river cruises are smaller ships and only have a limited number of each cabin category available. Specific categories are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Every effort will be made to accommodate your cabin choice at the time of reservation; however, if that cabin category is no longer available, the closest available category will be offered. Please enquire through our Client Care Centre for any upgrade fees which will apply for different cabin categories. Suites are available on a very limited basis.

Embarkation on day 2 is after 3:00 p.m.; on day 9, disembarkation is 9:00 a.m. at the latest.

Single accommodations are extremely limited. Single rate subject to change based on availability. Triple and child accommodations are not available.

To complete your tour, we <u>include</u> roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your <u>own air</u>, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Our transfers will depart from Amsterdam, Netherlands airport and return to Zurich, Switzerland airport.

Air travellers will arrive into Amsterdam, Netherlands airport and depart from Zurich, Switzerland airport.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Return flights should not be booked prior to 11:00 a.m.

The cruise line reserves the right to charge a supplemental fuel charge. Should this charge be incurred, you will be notified in advance.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more travelling on the same flights and dates.

PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP: PASSPORTS AND VISAS
